for approximately eight months during 1931 1932 anthropologist margaret mead lived with and studied the mountain arapesh a segment of the population of the east sepik province papua new guinea she found a culture based on simplicity sensitivity and cooperation in contrast to the aggressive arapesh who lived on the plains both the men and the women of the mountain settlements were found to be in mead s word maternal the mountain arapesh exhibited qualities that many might consider feminine they were in general passive affectionate and peaceloving though mead partially explains the male s femininity as being due to the type of nourishment available to the arapesh she maintains social conditioning to be a factor in the type of lifestyle led by both sexes mead s study encapsulates all aspects of the arapesh culture she discusses betrothal and marriage customs sexuality gender roles diet religion arts agriculture and rites of passage in possibly a portent for the breakdown of traditional roles and beliefs in the latter part of the twentieth century mead discusses the purpose of rites of passage in maintaining societal values and social control mead also discovered that both male and female parents
