

Speakout Students Preintermediate

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listening 1 develops students ability to understand real life spoken english through recordings of spontaneous natural speech which have been carefully selected and edited for pre intermediate learners the activities are designed to encourage students to draw on their own natural listening strategies and to apply them effectively in the context of language learning

this title uses a variety of imaginative activities to develop oral fluency encouraging students to draw on their own life experience

cambridge english empower is a general adult course that combines course content from cambridge university press with validated assessment from the experts at cambridge english language assessment the pre intermediate student s book gives learners an immediate sense of purpose and clear learning objectives it provides core grammar and vocabulary input alongside a mix of skills speaking lessons offer a unique combination of functional language pronunciation and conversation skills alongside video filmed in the real world each unit ends with a consolidation of core language from the unit and focuses on writing within the context of a highly communicative mixed skills lesson this version of the student s book does not provide access to the video assessment package and online workbook a version with full access is available separately

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each unit of speakout opens with a clear overview of the content and learning objectives the course covers all 4 skills areas as well as grammar and vocabulary and functional grammar each unit culminates with a dvd lesson based around an extract from a real bbc programme the active book includes easy navigation of the students book pages with zoom facility video and audio available at the touch of a button video podcasts with accompanying worksheets bbc programme clips that can be played in a dvd player or computer

cambridge skills for fluency is a learner centred range of materials designed specifically to develop students fluency and confidence in listening speaking reading and writing the books are at four levels from pre intermediate through to advanced and are suitable for use as supplementary texts or as core texts on skills development courses each book in the cambridge skills for fluency series promotes fluency by presenting a wide variety of both old and new topics in creative and imaginative ways genuinely engages students interest and encourages them to share personal reactions and opinions fluently focuses on a particular skill but the other skills are integrated in a way that reflects real life use of language contains twenty units designed to take about an hour of class time a detailed contents map and brief teaching notes
